Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before making your booking

Glastonbury Goddess Temple is a registered Place of Worship, licensed to conduct legal marriages. The marriage ceremony is conducted by either Giorgia Farano, Sharlea Sparrow or Iona Jones - all Priestesses of Avalon and Temple Registrars for legal marriages. The ceremony includes the signing of the marriage certificate, which means that the marriage is legally binding. Couples who are resident within the EU and outside of the EU can be legally married in the Goddess Temple. For the legal marriage to take place two payments are necessary – one to the Mendip District Registrar’s office and one to Glastonbury Goddess Temple. See below for more information.

How to proceed:

1. Please contact Iona Jones, our Goddess Temple Registrar for legal marriages to see if your preferred Wedding date in the Goddess Temple is available.

2. Contact your local register office to register Notice of Marriage.

3. You will be asked by the Registrar to set a date for a Notice of Marriage Interview with them, which generally lasts for an hour. A Fee of £35 per person is payable to the register office - this payment is separate from payments made to Glastonbury Goddess Temple.

4. At the interview please advise the Registrar that the Goddess Temple is the only registered place of Pagan Worship and that you are exempt from clause b. as you are a resident in the UK.

a) Your place of marriage is recorded as:

“The Goddess Temple, Room on the 1st floor of The Courtyard, 2-4 The High Street Glastonbury.”
The marriage registration number is 44925.

b) The Goddess Temple is your usual place of worship.

c) You wish to marry according to the rites of The Goddess People of Avalon, and this is the nearest registered building of this denomination (as per Section 35(1) of marriage Act 1949) to where either of you reside.

d) You may be asked by your registrar where to send your 'Authorities', these are blue forms which have all the information from your interview, i.e. name, address etc. Please advise the registrar to send them to us at the Goddess Temple, here they are filed in a secure place until the day of your marriage.

5. Please notify your Priestess Registrar of the date of your interview for giving notice of marriage.

6. Residents from inside and outside of the EU will be guided by the Registry Office staff as to how to proceed. Please call Taunton Registry Office on: 01823 28225. Opening Hours Monday to Friday 9am to 5.50pm

7. The Fee for a Legal Wedding Ceremony in Glastonbury Goddess Temple is £1700.

The Glastonbury Goddess Temple Fee includes:

- i) Full consultation with the Ceremonialist for your bespoke Sacred Marriage & Legal Wedding Ceremony.
- ii) Legal Sacred Marriage Ceremony conducted by a Priestess of Avalon in Glastonbury Goddess Temple on the Isle of Avalon.
- iii) Private access to Glastonbury Goddess Temple for up to 30 people *
- iv) Decorated sacred Inner Circle, made with ivy and flowers.
- v) Ceremonial equipment, including incense, candles, chalice, sacred waters, ring cushion, ribbons, etc..
- vi) Sacred Ceremonies: Sacred Incense Blending For Beloveds and the Cake and Mead Ceremony.
- vii) Additional Goddess Temple Melissa to attend and prepare the Goddess Temple for your ceremony.

Booking

A non-refundable deposit of £100 is paid at the time of booking, with the final balance of £1600 to be paid no later than six weeks before the marriage takes place. Monthly payments are accepted, please advise Iona Jones that you wish to set up a standing order. Iona will contact you with account details prior to your consultation with your Priestess Registrar. If notice is given for cancellation no later than six weeks before the wedding when the balance has been paid in full, then the balance will be refunded, excluding the £100 deposit and £260 admin and consultation fees. The consultation with the Priestess registrar will take place once the deposit has been transferred, a separate invoice will be sent to you stating the time allowed for transfer of the deposit, which is 7 days from the time of booking.

Please note: the Goddess Temple is open to the public seven days a week from 12-4pm. Weddings are conducted after closing, at 6pm.
